Welcome to our online scholarship application process. The Northwest Michigan Industrial Association will accept online and typewritten applications only. Applications will be accepted from February 1 through April 15. Scholarship recipients are notified during the first week of May and will be recognized at our Annual May Event, which takes place the evening of the 4th Thursday of May. To be considered for a scholarship the following requirements must be met:

- You must be a current employee of a Northwest Michigan Industrial Association Member Company or a dependent of an employee.
- Applicant must be currently enrolled or accepted in a college, university, skilled trades, or other technical training program.
- Applicant may attend full-time or part-time.
- Priority is given to manufacturing and industrial related course work.
- Complete an essay outlining your educational or training intentions, attach copy of transcripts, letters of recommendations, a description of extra-curricular and or community involvement, list of academic and or non-academic awards and achievements and letters of recommendation from employers, teachers, mentors, advisors, etc. and any other supporting documentation.
- Scholarship recipients are eligible for a one-time award.
- Submitted information should be to the best of your knowledge, complete and accurate.
